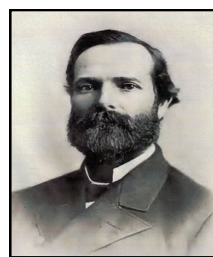

Approved by Resolution No. 2022-19  
Effective June 14, 2022



Irrigation of all exterior landscaping including, but limited, turf areas, open ground, crops, trees, grass, lawn, ground cover, shrubbery, or decorative plantings using an irrigation system, hose or outdoor potable water faucet shall be allowed only two days a week as follows:

Penalties for  
Violations of Water  
usage Restrictions

> First Notice: \$100.00 <  
> Second Notice: \$200.00 <  
> Third Notice & Subsequent: \$500.00 <  
\*In addition, persons cited for violations may be required to pay for the installation of one or more of the following: Automatic sprinklers, flow restriction devices, low-flow toilet.
