KEEPING UP WITH HUGHSON

Gilton Rates Increasing

*Starting January 2024 garbage rates will increase from \$35.02 to \$36.07.

*An Additional can will increase from \$15.42 to \$15.88.

Christmas Tree Collection Program

Gilton Solid Waste Management will be doing curbside collection of Christmas trees After the holiday trees will be collected during the first two FULL weeks in January 2024 starting **on January 8th and ending on January 19th.**

- Trees need to be in front of the house including residents that have alley service, trees will be collected on customer's **GARBAGE** collection day.
- Trees need to have all metal stands, lights and ornaments removed (wood stands are OK.)
- Trees should be placed on the street surface Next to the curb, but a minimum of 6 feet away from cars.
- Treated trees (flocking, paint, fireproofing) are preferred to be cut up and put in the garbage cans, but it is not required.
