Connecting Communities On The S

The Stanislaus Regional Transit Authority (StanRTA) is launching systemwide service changes on March 5, 2023, as a result of its Comprehensive Operational Analysis (COA) findings from 2022. The changes will help provide transit equity across The S service area. The "Connecting Communities on The S" service launch will add 200+ new bus stops and partially redesign most routes. StanRTA has detailed service change information for each route at www.RidetheS.org.

Highlights include:

- Added Sunday Bus Service
- Added 60-Minute Service Frequency
- Bidirectional Routes to Improve On-Time Performance
- Three New Routes
- Ceres Mobility Hub

All services on The S will be free from March 5 through 18 to celebrate Go Green Weeks. Riders are encouraged to purchase and activate multi-day passes accordingly. Passes are not refundable once activated.



City of Hughson spring cleaning 2023

The City of Hughson and Gilton Solid Waste Management, Inc. will be providing a Waste Disposal Voucher Program this year from **May 1 through July 31, 2023**, as an alternative to the annual "Clean Up Day" event, which is usually held the first weekend in May of each year.

The voucher will be good for a one-time free dumping fee at Gilton Resource Recovery/Transfer Facility, Inc. located at 800 S. McClure Rd. Modesto CA. This voucher is being sent to all residential garbage customers residing within the City of Hughson who have garbage service. **Please read the voucher carefully as it contains information on the dates it is valid and what is required at the time of use.**
