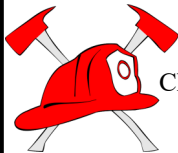

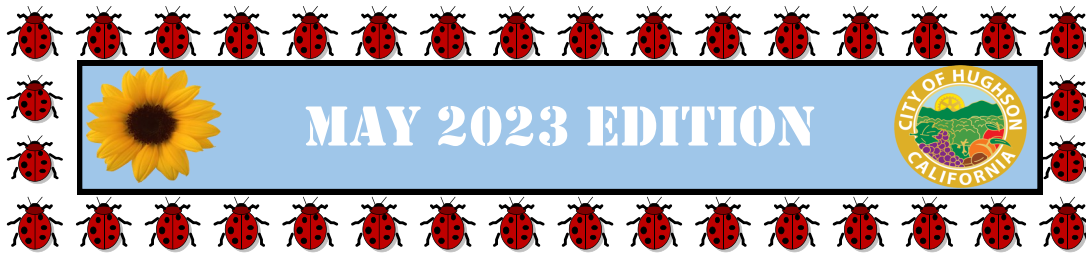

May: National Pet Week 2023: May 2nd through May 7th. SASA recommends half price adoptions for those five days (dogs at \$60.00 and cats \$30.00).

June: All cats & Kittens-"2 for the price of 1" cat adoptions in recognition of national Adopt a shelter cat month. This is the prime "cat season" when we see a large influx of kittens in the cat population. Spay/neuter is still provided at no cost to any stray cat within our jurisdiction as provided through the Dogwood Animal Rescue Project, MOU, dated August 2021. The normal \$60 per cat adoption fee would be waived for every second cat adopted by any single adopter.

City of Hughson Spring Cleaning 2023

The City of Hughson and Gilton Solid Waste Management, Inc. will be providing Waste Disposal Voucher Program this year from **May 1 through July 31, 2023**, as an alternative to the annual "Clean Up Day" event, which is usually held the first weekend in May of each year.

The voucher will be good for a one-time free dumping fee at Gilton Resource Recovery/Transfer Facility, Inc. located at 800 S. McClure Rd. Modesto CA. This voucher is being sent to all residential garbage customers residing within the City of Hughson who have garbage service. **Please read the voucher carefully as it contains information on the dates it is valid and what is required at the time of use.**



Portable Basketball hoops obstructing the public right of way.

There have been numerous complaints regarding portable basketball hoops on public streets and sidewalks.

This is a reminder that this is a Hughson Municipal Code Violation, that can be enforced with Administrative Citations.

12.36.010 Prohibition of obstruction.

It shall be unlawful to obstruct or cause to be obstructed any part of, or any part of the public use of, any public street, highway, avenue, sidewalk, space between sidewalk and street, crosswalk, wharf or bridge (collectively, the public ways). Obstructions shall include but not be limited to any person, object, article, structure, vehicle or animal sitting, standing or otherwise physically remaining on or in the path of the public ways, without necessity, which act or acts impede or impair the passage of the public or of any person, vehicle or animal lawfully passing over, on or along said ways. (Ord. 04-09 § 1, 2004)

Alley clean up

The Hughson Public Works and Utilities Dept. spent the entirety of Hughson Has Heart Clean Up Day cleaning and removing weeds and debris from alley ways. This is a reminder that debris, junk, garbage, weeds and maintenance are the homeowners responsibility and violations can be enforced with Administrative Citations.

Thank you for doing your part to keep Hughson an undeniably great place to be!

Don't forget to pay your Utility Bill or request a payment plan by sending a request in or calling City Hall by the last business day of the month to avoid a 10% penalty.

(For card auto payments don't set draft date prior to the 10th)

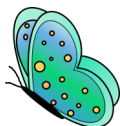
