ATTENTION HUGHSON RESIDENTS & BUSINESS OWNERS!

California Senate Bill 1383 (Re: Recycling Organic Waste) has been finalized by the State and will go into effect January 1, 2022

- This law effects households, businesses, & government entities. The main targets for CA SB 1383
 are to reduce the amount of organics being landfilled, and to rescue edible surplus food.
- Organics and recyclables must be separated from the trash, which will require all trash to be taken
 to a high-diversion facility where organics and recyclables are sorted prior to trash
 being disposed of.
- Starting January 2022 garbage rates will increase to \$35.02.
