Staff Recommendation:

Recommend that the City Council accept the donation of refrigerator, freezer, removal of a sink, and the purchase and installation of metal cabinets and shelving, valued at \$5,300.00, by Hughson Youth Baseball and Softball for the Concession Stand at Lebright Fields, and approve the donation agreement.

Discussion:

City staff was recently contacted by Hughson Youth Baseball and Softball (HYBS) regarding the purchase of improvements for the new concession stand at Lebright Fields, which was installed on January 9, 2024. The Public Works Superintendent indicated that these items would have been purchased by the City in the near future. The HYBS President indicated that HYBS would like to cover the entire cost of the improvements, and the installation. Detailed specifications, and an estimate of the purchase is attached.

If approved by the City Council. The installation of the improvements will take place prior to the scheduled HYBS Opening Day on March 30, 2024.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated cost of the project is \$5,300.00. If approved, staff intend to work with HYBS representatives as needed during the installation.





Subject: Recommendation that City Council Waive the Fees Pertaining to the Use

of Rolland Starn Park (Keith Crabtree Field) for Hughson Youth Baseball

and Softball for the 2024 Regular Season

Presented By: Jose Vasquez, Public Works Superintendent

Staff Recommendation:

1. Recommend that the City Council waive the fees pertaining to the use of Rolland Starn Park/Keith Crabtree Field for Hughson Youth Baseball/Softball for the 2024 regular season.

2. Find that the waiver of the fees pertaining to the use of Rolland Starn Park/Keith Crabtree Field for Hughson Youth Baseball/Softball for the 2024 regular season is in the public interest.

Discussion:

Starting in 2014, Hughson Youth Baseball and Softball (HYBS) inquired about the use of Keith Crabtree Field to allow HYBS to better accommodate the number of games planned for the season. HYBS also anticipated using the lights at Keith Crabtree Fields a few times during the season to showcase games at night—a unique experience for local youth.

HYBS requested a waiver for their inaugural use of Keith Crabtree Fields in exchange for improvements to the baseball diamond. The City Council approved the waiver in 2014 and has continued to do so each year based on the public interest served and the fact that the planned improvements exceeded what would be generated in usage fees.

Staff met with HYBS representatives this month to discuss the arrangement details for the 2024 season. This season, HYBS would like to waive fees at Starn Park, in exchange for improvements to the diamonds at Lebright Fields and Starn Park. The improvements to the park are scheduled to be completed on March 16, 2024, and the opening day ceremonies for the 2024 season are scheduled for March 30, 2024.

The list of improvements is below:

Starn Park

Replace dirt as needed for the infield; Replace wood as needed in the dugouts; Adjust base pegs

Lebright Fields

Reset base pegs in multiple fields; Lay concrete next to batting cages (for toolbox container); Infield leveling (sand/clay mix); T-ball field improvements

Keith Crabtree Field at Starn Park, and Lebright Fields are maintained by the city. The partnership with HYBS will result in added improvements to the baseball diamonds above and beyond what is typically done with existing City resources. Additionally, the completed improvements will be enjoyed by not only HYBS but other park users throughout the year. The improved condition of the baseball diamonds should help generate additional revenue through expanded use of the park and encourage long standing users to continue to use the fields. The estimated cost of the improvements more than covers the cost of the rental fee for the park. As such, it is in the public's interest to waive the park rental fees in exchange for the completed improvements provided by HYBS.

Fiscal Impact:

The revenue that would be generated through the use of Keith Crabtree Field by HYBS for the season is approximately \$3,120, not including usage for lights. This year, the proposed improvements and labor are estimated at \$4000, and exceed the revenue the city would have received without the fee waiver.
